Northwest Children's Home Education Center is an accredited school. We provide education for all of our residents on campus from grades 6 through 12. We also provide education for community children from Lewiston, Clarkston, and surrounding communities. The classrooms for our community students range from Kindergarten to Seniors, as well as those that may need some extra support to graduate. Teachers are able to guide and give more support to students within the classroom as each classroom works with a 5:1 ratio. This support helps all students achieve their potential as well as build healthy relationships with each of the students in the classroom.

"Jimmy" is an elementary student that is educated at the Education Center. When "Jimmy" moved to the Valley, his family was looking for a school environment like his previous school. The family tried having "Jimmy" attend the public schools, but it was too much for him. He was over stimulated throughout the day, resulting in his becoming dysregulated in and out of class.

"Jimmy" was not able to obtain his education in this setting; it was not the best learning environment for him. Once the decision was made for "Jimmy" to attend the Ed Center, his outbursts declined and he was able to make progress in several academic areas. The teachers and staff work daily to help "Jimmy" use coping skills he has learned before he becomes upset or over stimulated. Relationships have been built with "Jimmy" and his parents, allowing him to continue to grow. This school is needed for many children like "Jimmy", as well as other local students with other specific educational needs. The staff at the Northwest Children's Home truly see the value in each and every individual that walks through the front doors.
